

**FLAT ROCK PLAYHOUSE THEATRE CLASSES &
YouTheatre PROGRAM
“CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION”**

Dear Students and Parents:

The Vagabond School of the Drama, Inc., a North Carolina non-profit corporation which operates under the name of Flat Rock Playhouse, is a professional theatre company, hosting professional productions throughout the year. YouTheatre is a part of the educational mission of this organization, and one that is vibrant, important and growing. While we treasure this growth, it creates facilities and supervision challenges that require the understanding and cooperation of all students and parents.

In order to ensure that everyone is “reading off the same sheet,” we have established some “ground rules” of participation in FRP programs. Please read the following “Conditions of Participation” carefully. With so many people coming and going at “The Rock,” we can only allow students who understand and meet these expectations to participate. If you are unable or unwilling to do so, please do not enroll in FRP programs. Enrollment constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

*****PLEASE READ CAREFULLY*****

Students taking classes through Flat Rock Playhouse shall:

- 1. BE SUPERVISED BY PARENTS BEFORE AND AFTER CLASS OR REHEARSAL TIME. No adult supervision of the grounds by FRP staff is available. Therefore, Parents are expected to supervise their children both before and after class or rehearsal times. Parents agree to drop off and pick up students only at designated times. Unsupervised students are not permitted on the FRP grounds at any time.*
- 2. REMAIN WITHIN YouTheatre-DESIGNATED AREAS. All YouTheatre students shall stay in class areas until picked up by parents. Only students enrolled in technical classes or working on mainstage productions or in supervised rehearsal shall be allowed into the cafeteria, backstage or mainstage areas. NO student shall be permitted in FRP housing areas at any time.*
- 3. COMPLETE AND SIGN A STUDENT INFORMATION & LIABILITY WAIVER FORM. This completed and signed form is required before students begin classes. Students are expected to inform instructor of changes to important information and to maintain accident and health insurance for their protection.*
- 4. MAINTAIN EXPECTED STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR. FRP students are ambassadors of the Playhouse and their Community. Abuse of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs are strictly prohibited while participating in FRP programs, both on and off the Playhouse grounds. Physical, verbal or sexual abuse of other students or instructors is prohibited.*

Failure by students or parents to adhere to the above “Conditions of Participation” shall result in the expulsion of the student from FRP programs, classes or productions, and the forfeiture of tuition.
